The Sudbury Symphony Orchestra is a Community Orchestra embarking on its 36th concert season in the City of Greater Sudbury, population 160 000, located approximately 4 hours north of Toronto. The orchestra performs a 6-concert season annually, with a professional core string quartet leading the string section, supplemented by community volunteers and per-service extra musicians. In addition the SSO core musicians engage in a comprehensive outreach and education program throughout the region. The core musicians of the SSO are members of the American Federation of Musicians.

### **Compensation:**

2011-12 Season

Orchestral Services: 42 services forecast at \$142.86 per service

Development Services: 35 services forecast at \$114.29 per service

5% AFM/EPW pension contribution and 4% vacation pay is added to each service

In addition to orchestral and development services the Principal Cello is responsible for teaching (individual and ensemble lessons) through the Sudbury Symphony Conservatory of Music. Compensation is a percentage of tuition generated plus 5% AFM/EPW Pension contributions and 4% vacation pay.

The SSO provides a group health benefit plan to its Core musicians.
